Econ has so many graphs, so it would be an additional tool that might be helpful.

This was my first econ class where I felt that everything that was explained made sense and the professor didn't just assume that it made sense. This professor was able to see where students would have difficulties and addressed them and because of that, the class was enjoyable for me. It

is rewarding to understand material, knowing that if I was confused I'd be frustrated and bored otherwise.

Ms. Hample really tried to tailor the class to her students, and made an effort to apply the principles in ways that would be relevant to us as business majors.
